Examples of community involvement include an ability to converse in either Czech / Slovak; attendance at a Czech / Slovak language school; membership or involvement in an organization such as MMI or Sokol; or participation in a Czech / Slovak dance, music, theater or church group.

Amount: MMI is awarding up to \$1,000 per successful applicant.

Requirements: Applicants are to submit a completed application form with appropriate documentation no later than October 31, 2020.
